The National Recreation and Parks Administration (NRPA) is collaborating with the Walt Disney Corporation to help fund local park improvement projects across the country. This collaboration challenges the Treasure Valley Pickleball Advocates (TVPA).

We have a positive and cost-free way of meeting our financial obligation in building the Hobbles Creek Park Pickleball Complex. It will not only benefit us but also the City of Boise Parks and Recreation Department (BPRD). Our task requires that we all spend some time on our computers each day this month.
