

THE 4 ON 4 OFF ROTATION SYSTEM AT HOBBLE CREEK

The rotation consists of 2 paddle lines. The first line of paddle holders is located on the 4 courts closest to the YMCA, in the breezeway. If those 4 courts are full please put your paddles in the holder on the left with the clip attached to the holder. When one of the games to 11 is finished on any of those 4 courts the 4 players must come off the court and the next paddle group will fill the court. Whichever paddle holder has the clip will be used to fill the empty court. The players that came off the court can now put their paddles back in the paddle holder together and if there are no other paddles before them, they will move the clip to their holder. They will be next in line to play.

If all 4 courts are full and all the paddle holders are full the clip moves to the right indicating the next 4 to come on the courts. Research at other complexes indicates this type of system has been very effective when courts are overcrowded. Although the courts may be very crowded, the rotation keeps the players from waiting forever to get back on court.

The same system will work with the additional 6 courts which are the 4 middle courts plus the two courts on the west side. The 2 championship courts will rotate the same and players must come off after each game to 11, while players are waiting.
